Richard Hurd from the "The White Lion Community Pub Ltd" spoke to the reasons as to why the company felt that the White Lion could be run as a viable business, countering arguments detailed in the planning application.

District Councillor Rose spoke to the breaches of planning control that have occurred, that the council will consult the services of a professional business viability assessor for licenced premises and that the application will be assessed at Planning Committee.

1599) To consider new planning applications

- a) CH/2014/1748/FA: The White Lion, Jenkins Lane, St Leonards, Buckinghamshire, HP23 6NW. Change of use of Public House with ancillary residential accommodation (Use Class A4) to use as a single dwelling house (Use Class C3) (Retrospective). The Parish Council resolved that it would respond strongly in opposition to the application, based on the following factors:
- i) The claim that the business is non-viable is factually incorrect and there are no exceptional circumstances under Core Strategy policy CS29 justifying a change of use.
- ii) The pub is a significant employment site, which has provided work for local people.
- iii) Community support for the White Lion pub being retained is overwhelming.
- b) CH/2014/1622/SA: Mildmay Cottage, Hawridge Common, Hawridge, Buckinghamshire, HP5 2UQ. Application for a Certificate of Lawfulness for the proposed use of the land for the temporary siting of a shepherds hut (caravan) for uses ancillary to Mildmay Cottage. The Parish Council had no comment on this application.
