In response to questions over the status of Cholesbury, Hawridge and Buckland Common villages categorised as 'washed over by the Green Belt' contrasted with St Leonards which was not categorised, Cllr Rose clarified that such categorisation could allow some limited infilling in these villages though other policies would afford significant protection from such development. Cllr Ingram raised a query with regard to provision for healthcare and education in the plan and District Cllr Rose agreed to report back on this matter. Cllr Brown raised concerns over inclusion of the Commons and historic monument areas on maps depicting infilling villages and would be commenting on in the consultation response.
