## CHOLESBURY-CUM-ST LEONARDS PARISH COUNCIL

The Meeting of the Parish Council held at St Leonards Parish Hall on Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> February 2020 at 8.00pm

- 5269) <u>To approve the minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2020 and attend to matters arising not raised elsewhere on the agenda Approved and signed by the Chairman</u>

### 5271) Reports from County and District Councillors

County Councillor Birchley highlighted her disappointment with the road surfaces along Swan Lane that had been laid last year and the fact that the top dressing was not satisfactory or robust enough to withstand farm machinery and the rural location. Recent very wet weather has exasperated the situation as flooding has washed away a lot of the top dressing. Councillor Birchley advised she had written to the new Director of Roads and the Highways Asset Management team and it is hoped that responses will be received shortly. In addition, chambers and gullies in the roads have filled up with debris due to the flooding issues and County Councillor Birchley has requested that these areas are cleaned out at the earliest opportunity.

Cllr Brown said the Parish Council was equally very concerned about the very poor quality of recent top dressing repairs to Swan Lane and previously the botched repairs on the road from The Vale via Hawridge Hill to Hawridge Common. He also undertook to write to Cllr Birchley about the lack of responsiveness to long-outstanding repair and drainage issues raised last August with the Local Area Technician and Depot Manager, Amersham.

District Councillor Rose highlighted the introduction of the new Community Infrastructure Levy for which more information to be published in due course. He thought it likely that the draft District Council Local Plan shortly due for public hearing by the Inspector would be adopted after April 2020 by the new Buckinghamshire Council.

Councillors noted that District Councillor Nick Rose was stepping down and would not be standing at the elections in May 2020. On behalf of the Councillors the Chairman took the opportunity to thank Cllr Rose for his commitment over many years to the concerns of residents and his conscientious work resolving issues on behalf of the Parish Council.

## 5273) Reports

(a) Chairman's Report and Questions to the Chairman

Cllr Brown attended a BALC meeting on the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2020 regarding plans for the new Unitary Authority. Matters covered including recent appointments, including the Communities and Partnership Director, Claire Hawkes and the proposed revenue and capital budget He had raised this parish council's concerns about the deteriorating performance of the planning service and the need for urgent action by the unitary authority which many other parishes then joined in with their support for a call for immediate improvements.

(b) Clerk's Report

The Clerk's report, circulated prior to the meeting was noted. Councillors also noted there were two outstanding allotment rents due and the clerk confirmed that these were being chased. Residents had contacted her about taking up vacant plots

## 5274) An update on forthcoming Parish Council elections

Councillors had received information from the Clerk regarding the forthcoming elections who was awaiting further information regarding nominations forms. Detailed information will be published on noticeboards, Hilltop News, Grapevine and the Council's website inviting residents of the parish to come forward as candidates. Councillors noted the key dates: Nominations open 31<sup>st</sup> Mach and close 7<sup>th</sup> April. The election will take place on the 7<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

Cllrs Brown and Matthews agreed to speak or meet with groups/residents/interested parties to ascertain if and how they might like to participate in the commemoration.

- Flooding issues on Oak Lane and problems with horse manure on nearby field landowner has been asked to rectify as soon as weather and field condition permit.

An update on these issues will be reported at the next meeting.

5279) <u>To consider matters relating to the Green at Buckland Common and Springall Hill Allotments</u> Cllr Brown thanked Cllr Matthews for the hedge-cutting work that he had undertaken within the parish.
