5314) To receive apologies for absence

Apologies received from Cllr Brackley, Cllr Matthews and Buckinghamshire Council Cllr N. Rose.

5315) To approve the minutes of the Meeting of the Parish Council held on 29th June 2020 and attend to matters arising not raised elsewhere on the agenda Approved and signed by the Chairman.

5318) Reports from Buckinghamshire Councillors

Cllr MacBean updated Councillors on the recent meeting with Transport for Bucks on the road issues in the parish. Following discussion actions were agreed. (noted in minute 5326c)

Cllr Brirchley reported on the first meeting of the Chesham and Villages Community Board and the associated Villages Forum, which will give an opportunity for Parish Councils to discuss village matters before the main Community Board meetings.

5320) Reports

(a) Chairman's Report and Questions to the Chairman

Cllr Brown advised he had attended the Villages Forum and first Board meeting of the Community Board. Action points to be reported on in due course. He had also attended a meeting arranged by the Chilterns Conservation Board, (see item 5322)

Councillors noted all the other Council policies that must be reviewed on an annual basis. received, prior to the meeting, and were content that these were all up to date

5322) Cholesbury Camp Management Plan

Councillors noted the Chiltern CB Cholesbury Camp Tree Survey report previously circulated. Cllr Brown reported on a meeting with the Chilterns Conservation Board, landowners of Cholesbury Camp and officers at Bucks Council. A management plan would be developed for dealing with the possible felling of up to six trees nearing the end of their life and surgery work on others and the need for a clear communication plan was also noted

5323) Website Review including compliance with new Accessibility Requirements

From 23rd September 2020 public bodies with websites need to comply with accessibility requirements legislation. Cllr Brown proposed that an external website designer undertake a review and audit the work to be done on the website. It was agreed to proceed and Cllr Brown will notify councillors of the cost of the work via email in due course.

5326) To consider matters relating to Highways and Rights of Way

(a) Update on cast iron signpost on Swan Lane

Noted that Buckinghamshire Council have approved a grant under devolution arrangements for the of repair of the signpost at a cost of £884 ex VAT and an order for the repair has now been placed by the parish council with Signpost Restoration Ltd

(b) Update on Abandoned Vehicle Taylors Lane

Cllr Brown advised that Cllr MacBean had been asked to chase up the Waste Contracts Officer at Buckinghamshire Council again to action the removal of the vehicle from the highway.

- (c) Update on road maintenance issues
 - i) Flooding on Jenkins Lane The Parish Council was extremely disappointed by the continuing delay in resolving the flooding issues raised over 12 months ago with TfB. This was discussed with the Cllrs. Birchley and MacBean who jointly undertook to take steps to expedite as a matter of urgency.
 - ii) Flooding at Dorriens Farm Though it was understood the under road pipework has now been cleared by a contractor however he had identified damage to the pipework and that the bore hole is blocked solid and will need re-boring. This was drawn to the attention of Cllr Birchley and MacBean who undertook to raise with TfB.
 - iii) White Lining warning signs and Roundals Though several roads had been completed others, including:- Cholesbury Lane from the Common to Buckland Common junction, Rays Hill, and the minor lanes in the parish remained outstanding and TfB would again be reminded to set dates for completing these repairs.
 - iv) Remedial resurfacing work Noted that surface dress on Swan Lane and Arrewig Lane had been completed and that remedial works on The Vale was programmed for Summer/ early Autumn.
 - v) Advisory Sign Hawridge Lane TfB to be chased again to replace this missing signage.
 - vi) Horseblock Lane Road Edges Noted that TfB have admitted they have no ready solution to restore the road edges. Current condition to be reviewed again.

5327) To consider matters relating to the Green at Buckland Common and Springall Hill Allotments

(a) Report on annual inspections of the allotments and The Green

The annual inspection of the allotments and the green took place on Saturday, 24th July 2020. Cllr Blomfield and Brown reported most allotments look well tended. Councillors discussed the disposal of compost on the plots. Specific allotment holders will be asked to tidy up and use compost bins. Councillors also agreed that the Green should be cut middle of August. Nigel Blomfield would arrange for this to take place.
