The Meeting of the Parish Council took place using video conferencing on Monday, 28th September at 5pm

The Chairman confirmed the meeting was being held under The Local Authorities (Coronavirus) (Meetings) Regulations 2020

5329) To receive apologies for absence

Apologies received from Cllr Sanger, Cllr Matthews and Buckinghamshire Council Cllr Birchley.

- 5333) Reports from Buckinghamshire Councillors

Cllr MacBean updated the PC on progress of the Chesham and Villages Community Board scheduled to have its second meeting later in the week.

5334) To suspend standing orders and invite questions from members of the public

There were no members of the public present.

5335) Reports

(a) Chairman's Report and Questions to the Chairman

Cllr Brown had met with Cllrs Birchley and MacBean, and Chairpersons from local village parish councils as a pre-meeting to discuss village priorities before the Community Board meeting. The focus of the meeting was for 6 parish councils to consolidate views and priorities, such as, neighbourhood planning and to work together on collective issues such as, better access to and responsiveness from Buckinghamshire Council especially on roads and planning.

Cllr Brown also attended the Transport for Bucks conference and the Community Forum meeting with the local police. 3 priorities police and community are encouraged to prioritise for next three months were speeding, residential burglary and anti-social behaviour.

(b) Clerk's Report

The clerks report was circulated prior to the meeting. It was also noted that the Planning Committee meeting on 10th August welcomed over 50 members of the public. Subsequently, the Parish Council received a significant number of objection letters with regard to one planning application, which it had been agreed by Buck Council could be submitted by the Parish Council on behalf of residents. The Parish Council submitted 158 objection letters to the Buckinghamshire Council Chiltern Area Planning Department. 28 letters received were from 'out of area' and were returned and redirected to the contributor to submit via the planning portal. The Chairman thanked the Clerk on behalf of the Council and residents for her hard work on this project.

5336) Governance Policies

(a) To review and if agreed approve a revised Risk Register

The risk register had been updated and an additional section on preparing and responding to national or regional emergencies has been added. It was approved by the Council

(b) To receive an update on the Website Accessibility Requirements

Cllr Brown updated Councillors who had received a first draft of an Accessibility Statement and noted that an updated version published on the website had met the deadline date of the 23rd

September 2020. Cllr Brown has been working with a website designer who has carried out an audit of the website and identified it would shortly be almost fully compliant with the statement and legislation. Additional website tracking data will be added to the website so the Parish Council will

shortly consider and approve an updated Data Privacy Policy including a Cookie Statement

5337) To consider BT's proposed removal of the payphone on Cholesbury Common

Councillors noted that the BT payphone in Cholesbury Common was scheduled to be removed. The Parish Council have the option to purchase the payphone kiosk for £1 but agreed not to pursue this.

 - Cllr Brown had contacted TfB as there had been no verge cutting in 2020 which was actioned in late August.

 - Cllr MacBean confirmed that enforcement was at last in progress over the abandoned vehicle in Taylor's Lane
- (c) Update on road maintenance issues and to deal with any new maintenance issues
 - i) Flooding on Jenkins Lane Cllr Blomfield reported a shallow bund has been tarmacked in front of the Hermitage and the flooding issue has, for the time being, now been resolved.
 - ii) Flooding at Dorriens Farm Cllr Blomfield reported that silt has been removed from the bore hole and is now working satisfactory though reboring of the bore hole will probably be required.. iii)Cast Iron Signpost Cllr Brown advised a new arm should be delivered for installation in the next few weeks or so
 - iv) White line issues are still outstanding. Cllr MacBean has agreed to chase this.
 - v) Advisory sign Hawridge Lane issue is still outstanding. It has been reported to TfB and now the Rights of Way Team, but there has been no response to date.
