The Chairman confirmed the meeting was being held under The Local Authorities (Coronavirus) (Meetings) Regulations 2020

- 5305) <u>To receive declarations of interest</u> Cllr Matthews declared an interest with a current planning matter.
- 5306) <u>Reports from Buckinghamshire Councillors</u> Cllr Birchley thanked all the volunteers in the parish for the support that has been offered to vulnerable and shielding residents during the lockdown.

Cllr Birchley advised the parish council that ditch digging works have taken place to address the issues in Jenkins Lane and Dorrians Farm. Councillors discussed the fact that these works had not addressed the flooding into Hermitage or Dorrians Farm and Cllr Birchley and Cllr McBean agreed to follow this up with Transport for Bucks.

Chiltern Hills Academy has two planning applications in progress to increase the capacity of the school.

The Chesham and Villages Community Board is scheduled to meet for the first time on the 14th July to set the programme of work programme and priority setting. Cllr Birchley and Cllr McBean are planning on creating a village forum for Chairmen and clerks so that the rural villages can discuss matters relevant to their parishes ahead of future community board meetings. Topics for discussion will include the environment, regeneration of jobs, public health, policing, voluntary organisations, roads, etc.

Cllr Brown asked if there will be training planned for the conduct of the Community Boards, as previously promised, and Cllr Birchely agreed to look into this further and advised the subsequent Community Board meeting is scheduled for the 30th September 2020.

Cllr McBean updated the parish council and answered questions on the activities taking place in a field on Cholesbury Lane Buckland Common and the enforcement and Stop Notices that has now been served.

The Hilltop Villages Volunteer Group has continued to work hard during lockdown and has completed over 400 errands for the community.

Concerns remain of the responsiveness of TfB officers to Highway issues. Cllr Birchley and Cllr McBean agreed to raise this again with TfB but also asked councillors to provide details on communications with TfB.

Councillors noted the highway work scheduled to take place on Swan Lane, Arrewig Lane and The Vale

Sandpit Hill – Cllr Blomfield reported an inspection plate is sinking on one side had been reported to Transport for Bucks online (via 'Fix my Street').

The muck heap on the field near Oak Lane continues to be a cause of concern with a continuing risk of mud on the road and contamination into the pond. Cllr Blomfield agreed to discuss this further with the landowner.

5312) <u>To consider matters relating to the Green at Buckland Common and Springall Hill Allotments</u> Councillors noted that a number of complaints to the parish council were received by residents following the mowing of Buckland Common. Those having complained have all received an email explaining the earlier than normal mowing had taken place because of the requirement to provide residents who had been under lockdown with sufficient safe space to exercise and for because the recourses available to cut the grass was very limited due to Covid-19.. It is expected to return to the normal schedule of cutting next year.

Councillors agreed to carry out an allotment inspection on Saturday, 25th July 2020 at 10.30am. Cllr Blomfield reported that some green waste from the allotments was being disposed of in the surrounding hedges. The clerk will contact all allotment holders to to advise they should use individual compost bins on their plots to deal with green waste.
