5565) Reports from Buckinghamshire Councillors

No Buckinghamshire Councillors were present at the meeting.

5566) To suspend standing orders and invite questions from members of the public

A member of the public raised concerns over the road condition near the Black Horse pub. It was noted despite this issue having been reported to Buckinghamshire Council over a year ago, the road surface still remains unrepaired. Cllr Brown advised the Parish Council had repeatedly raised concerns with Buckinghamshire Council about the hazardous condition of the excess gravel accumulation and underlying road surface and agreed to again pressure on Buckinghamshire Council to remedy the situation.

A member of the public also raised the concern regarding the last-minute postponement of a planning appeal in the parish. Cllr Brown agreed the communication from the Enforcement team at Buckinghamshire Council on the action they are taking to bring this case to resolution has not been good enough. Cllr Brown will again discuss this with Cllr Jane Macbean.

5567) Reports

(a) Chairman's Report and Questions

The Chairman recently attended the Village Forum Meeting, which comprises the six rural parishes surrounding Chesham. Discussions took place regarding the lack of responsiveness to concerns/issues raised with Buckinghamshire Council and that this was wholly unsatisfactory. The recently issued of a revised Charter on Buckinghamshire Council commitment to Parish and Town Councils had committed to respond in a reasonable time to all communications made to them and to also provide to parish councils a list of key officers. To date these commitments had not been fulfilled and he had subsequently written to Buckinghamshire Council requesting they remedy this.

Councillors were asked to note that the details of the Local Government Boundary Commission review of wards in Buckinghamshire Council has just been published and the Chairman will circulate this information to the rest of the Councillors. It was pleasing to see the Parish Council's suggestions for Chiltern Ridges Ward had been adopted.

(b) Clerk's Report

Councillors noted that the internal audit paperwork and notices were published on the noticeboards and website before the 1st July 2022 deadline.

(c) Update on Broadband Project

On behalf of Cllr Ingram the Chairman reported that Openreach had confirmed More than 85% of the 394 premises in the Cholesbury fibre installation project should go live on or before 15th September. The remaining 50 plus premises will follow within a month or so once two pole replacements have been installed by Openreach.
