The Clerk reported that recently, the defibrillator located at Cholesbury Village Hall was recalled due to issues found with that model by the manufacturer with battery life . When the engineer carried out an inspection of the machine, significant issues with the Therapy Board inside was also highlighted, which also needs replacing. The unit is out of warranty and with significantly high repair costs the Clerk has made some enquiries to the Community Board as to whether they would fund a replacement unit. In principle, this has been agreed and ongoing discussion continues as to the overall costs.
